### Lots Goin' On 'Round the Ol' Lodge These Days

As I write this update to all of our 880+ Members, I'm struck by the thought that the summer months were supposed to be a bit more relaxed, what with only one Lodge Meeting in each of the months of July and August. Apparently, I didn't "get the memo." It's been an action-packed summer, and the pace continues into the Fall. Nonetheless, it's been good stuff though:

Our Veterans Services Committee worked on elevating our profile in the community with several tangible activities:

1. They erected a sign near the entrance to the Northern California Veterans Cemetery (at Igo) indicating "Redding Elks Club Supports Our Troops." This sign complements a similar sign which our Emblem 515 Sisters erected along the same corridor over a year ago. Elks support to Veterans and our Troops is clearly manifest near the Igo cemetery.
2. They secured and presented \$500 grants from the Lodge Charity Account to support two local, veterans-related community projects: the Anderson Veterans

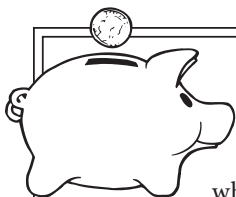

James pursued and crafted local interest stories about Lodge Members, their contributions and activities. More recently, we wound up with "our name in lights" in the Record Searchlight highlighting the Lodge's \$500 contribution to the Anderson Veterans Walk of Honor on August 30th. We've recently submitted another press release on our contribution to the Marine Corps League project mentioned above.

**DDGER Visit:** As I write this piece, I've just put the finishing touches on over 20 committee reports and packages to present to our Deputy District Grand Exalted Ruler (DDGER) for the North District. **Wade Thorpe** (Chico Lodge) is our DDGER this year, and he represents the guidance and agenda of Elks Grand Lodge, headquartered in Chicago. He and a small team of Grand Lodge representatives reviewed our administrative practices, our facilities, our activities, and other aspects of being a well-run Elks Lodge at their September 15th visitation. This is a once-a-year, cyclical event and we appreciate having these distinguished guests visit and provide us feedback on our operations. 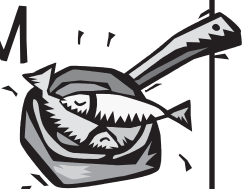

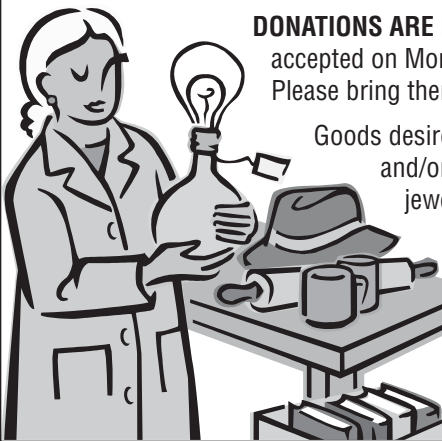
