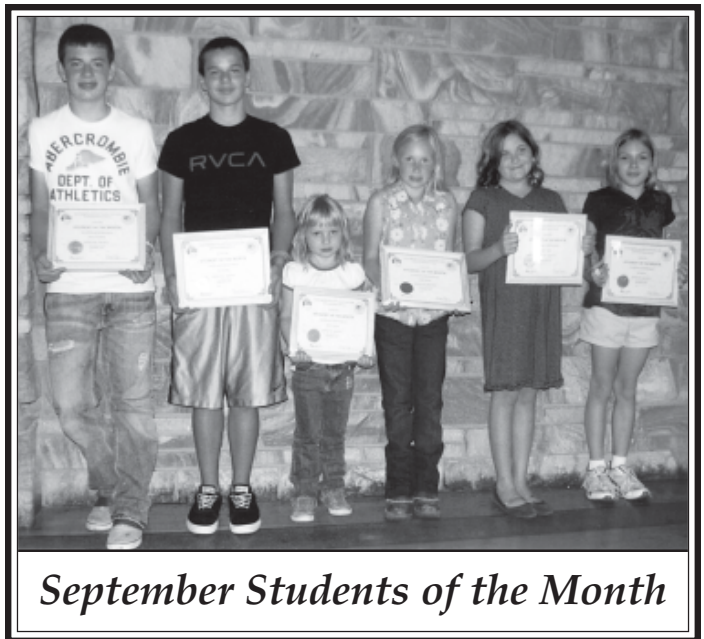
## EMBLEM CHRISTMAS BAZAAR
