REVISIONS TO THE BY-LAWS and RULES of ORDER of REDDING LODGE #1073

At our regular meeting on February 17, 2011 we will vote on the By-Law revisions proposed below or any other changes needed. This is a normal procedure required by Grand Lodge every five years.

Article IV MEETINGS

Current: July, August, November and December

To read: July and August.

Article V ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 4. OF THE SECRETARY

Current: for the faithful performance of his duties, he shall receive a compensation of \$600.00 per annum payable semi-annually.

To read: \$3,000.00, per annum, payable Quarterly.

Section 5, OF THE TREASURER

Current: for the faithful performance of his duties, and shall receive as compensation for his services, he shall receive the sum of \$300.00 per annum.

To read: the sum of \$300.00 per annum, payable quarterly.

Article X FEES and DUES

Section 2: current: On or before April 1st, all members, including Life Members, shall pay the Grand Lodge per capita fee, Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues, in addition to the appropriate regular or Life Member dues as specified in the remainder of this Section.

To read: On or before April 1st, all members, including Life Members shall pay the Grand Lodge per capita fee, Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, State Association Dues, and the North District per capita fee. in addition to the appropriate regular or Life Member dues as specified in the remainder of this section.

LODGE LOOKING FOR BLT CONTRIBUTIONS

One of the State Programs we support as Elks Lodge members is the Major Project. But, did you know there is another program that works hand in hand with the Purple Pig? It is the BEQUESTS AND LIVING TRUSTS FUND.

The BLT is funded through larger gifts (minimum \$10,000) and provides benefits to the grantor depending on the type of commitment made. For example, if \$10,000 is donated, the money goes into a Charitable Remainder Trust. The grantor is paid up to 7% of the trust value each year so long as the donor or their spouse is living. After both the husband and wife pass away, the value of the trust is transferred to the CHEMPI program to help disabled children. Property and securities can also be donated. In addition, your gift may qualify for a tax deduction.

Another way to help the BLT that does not require an immediate cash outlay is to name the BLT in your Will. You will continue to help disabled children even after you are gone. For questions regarding BLT and to find out how you can earn up to 7% income from your gift, please contact me.
