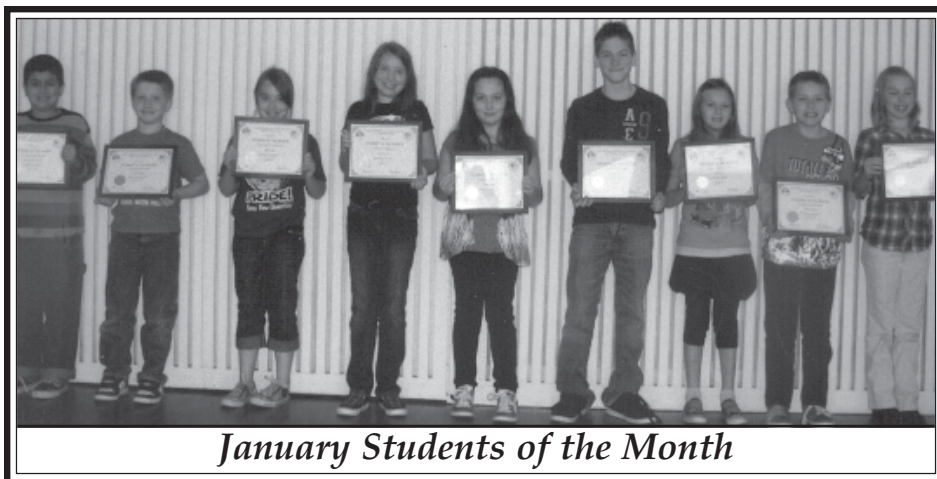
The Up-Coming 2011-2012 Fiscal Year! Need Volunteers to Chair/Staff Lodge Committees!

Annotated Statutes, Section 14.160

"A member owing one year's dues to the Lodge shall be dropped from the rolls prior to April 1st without the vote of the Lodge, thereon, provided that the delinquent

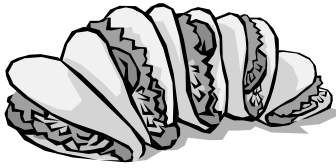

Delinquent Members shall be read on the Lodge floor and published in the Lodge BULLETIN. Delinquent Members shall not have any privileges of the Lodge during his/her delinquency. In the event of his/her being dropped for non-payment of dues, he/she can be reinstated only in the manner provided in the Laws of the Order.

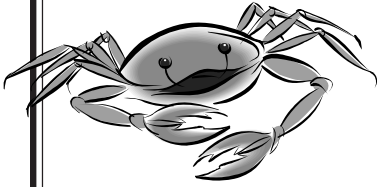
A "Super" Super Bowl Party


