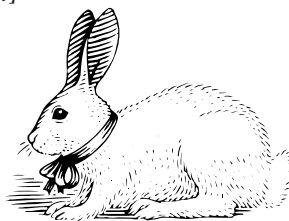
## KITCHEN KORNER

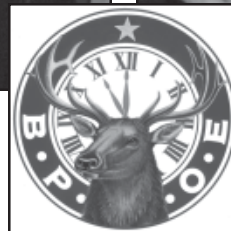
