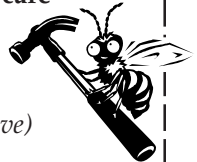

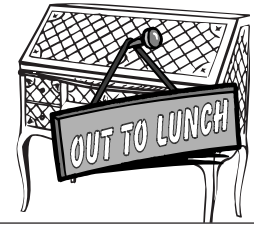

### ANNOTATED STATUTES, SECTION 14.160

"A member owing one year's dues to the Lodge shall be dropped from the rolls prior to October 1st without the vote of the Lodge, thereon, provided that the delinquent Member has been given a written notice of the proposed action thereon not less than thirty days prior to October 1st by the Secretary of the Lodge."

Delinquent Members shall be read on the Lodge floor and published in the Lodge *BULLETIN*. Delinquent Members shall not have any privileges of the Lodge during his/her delinquency.

In the event of his/her being dropped for non-payment of dues, he/she can be reinstated only in the manner provided in the Laws of the Order.

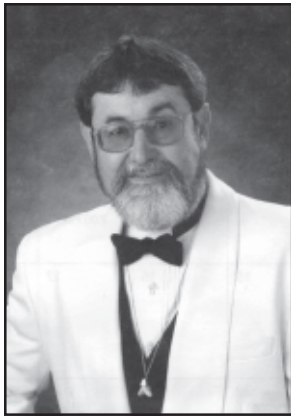

# Introducing George A. Waters, No. District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler 2010-2011



George was born December 16, 1954 in Kansas City, Missouri to Louise and Harry Waters. A younger sister Mary was born in October of 1959. A year later, the family moved to Willows due to his father's occupation as a Merchant Marine, sailing out of San Francisco.

George's career in leadership began in high school as a member of the Future Farmers of America. He served all four years as secretary of the Parliamentary Procedure Team and as chapter secretary for his junior and senior years. George received the State Farmer Degree as a junior for leadership in the organization, community activities, and his livestock project. He served as Superior Region Treasurer in 1971 and 1972.

In fall of 1972, George entered California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo, CA with the intent of becoming an agriculture teacher. Later that year his ideas changed, and he changed his major to mechanized agriculture. He took great interest in surveying and building construction, which in the future would help secure his career with the United States Forest Service.

In March of 1977, George took a temporary position as a draftsman with the Forest Service. In the following months he completed some elective college units needed to finish his Bachelor of Science Degree and received it in December of 1977. About this time, he was offered a permanent position as a Civil Engineering Technician. His duties included serving as party chief of a survey crew to collect field information for design and reconstruction of logging roads, design of these roads, drafting of plans, cost estimates, and assembly of these items into Timber Sale Road Packages. In the mid 1990's his interest turned to construction. He passed written and oral exams for certification in road and building construction inspection. He is currently serving as Forest Maintenance Specialist and plans to

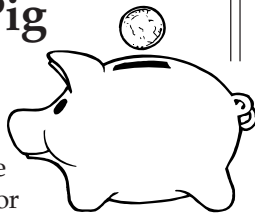
retire December 31, 2010 with 33 years and 8 months of experience.

George was initiated into the Willows Elks Lodge on March 3, 1998. He served on the House Committee, was appointed Lodge Esquire in 1999, went through the chairs, and was elected Exalted Ruler in 2003. His Lodge chairmanships, spanning several years, include Lodge Activities, Flag Day, Scouting, and Hoop Shoot. Since 2000, George also served the North District in several capacities: Chairman for Lodge Activities, Ritual Contest, Piggy Bank and Membership. He is also active in the Knights of Columbus, reaching the Fourth Degree in 2005. George was elected to serve as North District Vice President in 2008.

In October of 1998 George married Cherylle and obtained a ready-made family of four children. Kane, Joshua, Tiffany and Benjamin. Cherylle joined the Elks in 2003, is a Past Exalted Ruler, and is a certified Floor Judge, Word Judge, and calculator for the Ritual Contest. In January of this year Cherylle was selected to serve as Piggy Bank Chairman for the North State. Cherylle and George have shared many great experiences and have made many friendships around our nation through the Elks.

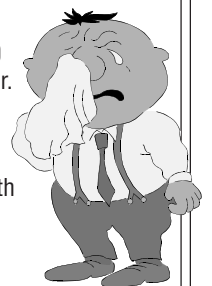

## Redding Traidusters RV Club News

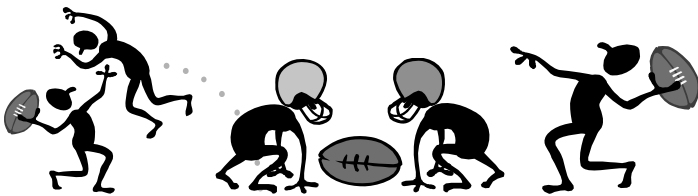
